Legacy Reserves Operating LP requests a 90-day extension to the Bureau of Land Management's request for action on the 3 subject wells.

South Justis Unit # G-21 (API # 30-025-11743)
South Justis Unit # G-25 (API # 30-025-11754)
South Justis Unit # H-15 (API # 30-025-25520)

In early March 2008, the BLM had requested action by May 28, 2008, to either re-activate or plug and abandon the subject wells although the wells did successfully pass the mechanical integrity tests performed in January 2008.

Due to our company's current high level of activity we were not able to comply with your request for action in this specific time frame. However, we are presently evaluating the wellbore conditions on these wells and we will be formulating a plan of action shortly. In the next two weeks we intend on submitting a recommendation and approval request to working interest owners for future action. Subsequently, once this plan is approved by the partners we intend on notifying your office of our plans and obtaining necessary regulatory approval.
