13 Describe Proposed or Completed Operation (clearly state all pertinent details, including estimated starting date of any proposed work and approximate duration thereof. The following is an initial plan to P&A the subject well. Conditions may change once operations are started. All changes will be approved by the BLM (within 50 Feet of Perfs).

1. Set CIBP at 3400' to cover perfs. 3478 - 3676'. Spot 35' cement on top of plug.
2. Perf. 2250' and place 100' plug at base of salt.
3. Attempt to pull casing from 1159'. Top of salt at 1150'. Place 200' cement plug from 1159' to 959'. If not able to pull 7" csg. at 1159', perf 1159' and place 100' plug outside and inside 7" csg.
4. Perf. 9-5/8" csg. at 379' and circulate cement from 379' to surface on 13" - 9-5/8" annulus and leaving cement inside 9-5/8" csg. fr. 379' to surface.
