1. APACHE CORPORATION requests the approval to test the B.O.P.'s on their LOCKHART "A-35" # 5 to 2000 PSI.

Maximum anticipated bottom hole pressures in the Blinebry, Tubb and Drinkard formations are estimated to be 1,600 psi, 1,700 psi and 1,800 psi respectively.

This is supported by a 24 hour shut in test performed on 9/5/08 indicating less than 1,000 psi bottom hole pressure after 24 hours on the Lockhart A-27 #12.

BOP/BOPE to be tested to
2000 psi with Independent Tester.
