Ladies and Gentlemen:

On September 22, 2008, Bureau of Land Management (BLM) completed a field examination of the abandoned Arapaho AKP Federal No. 1 well, located 330' FSL and 1650' FEL in Section 29, T. 26 S., R. 33 E., Lea County, New Mexico.

All final abandonment requirements have been met except for vegetative growth (20%) established evenly across the location. BLM will continue to monitor the surface restoration of this abandoned well site. All final abandonment requirements will have been met when BLM is confident that the disturbed surfaces are capable of being restored to a condition similar to their original state.
