If decision made to frac, will frac using crosslink fluid carrying 180,000 lbs sand.

Set a 10K composite plug at 8275', perf the 1st Bone Spring Sand, 7974', 7975', 7976', 8120', 8121' 1 spf (5), 8028'-32' 2 spf (10) and acidize with 1800 gals. NE Fe 7.5% HCL.

If decision made to frac, will frac using crosslink fluid carrying 200,000 lbs sand.
