Norvell, OK, I now have these copies and in reviewing them the C-104 is wrong and we cannot approve until corrections are made.

1st. For downhole commingle a C-104 needs to be sent in for each zone that is producing.

- a. C-104 for NE Bell Lake Delaware; needs pool code, property code, perfs only for Delaware, tubing size and depth, and Downhole production test (whole test coming up from all perfs in the wellbore)
- b. C-104 for Wildcat Bone Spring: needs property code, perfs only for Bone Spring, Tubing size and depth, and Downhole production test (whole test coming up from all perfs in the wellbore) this test should be the same as is on the C-105 and the C-104 for the Delaware.

Please correct and send correct number of C-104's.

I will go ahead and check out what I have and when I get the corrected C-104s I will get them approved and scanned today.
