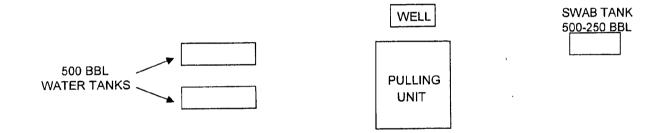

Mr. Hill:

On 10-16-2009 I contacted Mr. Carl Chavez with the Environmental Division of the Oil Conservation Division in Santa Fe to explain that Yates Petroleum Corporation had discovered internally that we had several approved C-144 CLEZ permits which involved work over activities where the work had been completed but due to a misunderstanding of the "new process" the C-144 CLEZ Closure Reports had inadvertently not been sent in.
