North El Mar Unit Temporarily Abandoned Wells

October 31, 2008

It is requested that Temporarily Abandoned status be continued for the temporarily abandoned wells in the North El Mar Unit, Lea County, New Mexico. Please refer to the Justification For Request For Temporarily Abandoned Status for these wells dated July, 2006 and the Status Updates dated June 25, 2007, September 28, 2007, December 19,2007, April 22nd, 2008, and June 20, 2008, and September 29, 2008.

As of the most recent Status Update, on September 29th, 2008, Oxy had announced that they had reached agreement with Plains Exploration (successor to Pogo Producing in the Cotton Draw Unit) to purchase the remaining 50% working interest in the Cotton Draw Unit and other properties. We have continue to have contact with Oxy to determine how this will affect work on the Cotton Draw Unit CO₂ flood, but have received no definitive answers. It appears that Oxy is still "digesting" their recent acquisitions.

On June 30th, 2008, Oxy announced an investment of \$1.1 billion to develop gas processing and pipeline infrastructure to produce 450 MMCFD of CO₂ capacity, expecting this to result in an increase in Oxy's Permian Basin oil production of 50,000 BOPD within 5 years. Conversations at the time with Oxy indicated that the Cotton Draw Unit was one of the primary proposed targets for this new CO₂ supply.

We are requesting extensions of TA status with the understanding that Sahara must show some definitive plans for these wells by June 30th, 2009. We will work diligently towards this, and failing that will begin preparations to reactivate any wells which show commercial potential, and plug and abandon those which, for lack of a CO2 project, do not.
