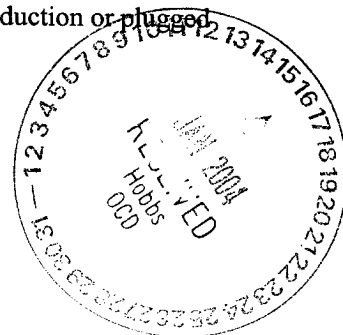

Subject well was temporarily abandoned on 8/21/03 but would not pass an MIT. Since that date, recent developments offsetting the well indicate that substantial gas production can be obtained but with copious volumes of water. Additional time is requested to further study the area before the well is either returned to production or plugged and abandoned. No adverse conditions exist by leaving the well temporarily abandoned.
