May 25, 2010, a hole developed in the bottom of an oil stock tank causing the escape of oil from the tank into the firewall area surrounding the tank. When discovered by the pumper, the tank was isolated from production. The area affected was contained inside the firewall around the stock tank. Attempted to recover oil standing inside the fire wall, none was recovered.

Notice was given on May 26, 2010 to Geoffrey R. Leking with NM Oil Conservation Division in Hobbs, New Mexico.

June 15 & 16, 2010: A crew was sent to the well site, cleaned up oil spill from leak in stock tank. Removed old abandoned gathering line crossing battery pad. Removed lines connecting tank, so back hole could get between tanks. Removed 198 yards of dirt contaminated with oil in and around tanks. Filled back in with good top soil. Hauled contaminated soil to Gandy-Marley, Inc Land Farm east of Roswell, New Mexico. Some of the work was witnessed by Maxey G. Brown, Deputy Inspector Compliance Officer with the Oil Conservation Division for the State of New Mexico.
