Drilling operations have been permanently suspended on this well at a total depth of 25'. No surface or conductor pipe was set. The drilled hole diameter is 12", drilled with a rat hole machine. The top 3' was sand and the next 22' was caliche. At 25' the well is not close to the nearest ground-water strata, estimated to be below 125' at this location, so there has been no impact to ground water. We will await NMOCD approval before commencing this operation and will give 24 hour notice to the NMOCD before commencing this operation.

The following procedure was discussed with Mr. E. L. Gonzales on July 8, 2010:

- Gravel Pack hole from 25' to 13' from surface.
- Displace 10' of Ready Mix concrete from 13' to 3' from surface.
- Weld steel plate onto a 3' piece of steel tubing and stick the tubing into the concrete. The plate will have the following information looking up: Robert E. Landreth-Rainbow 16 State well No. 2, API Number 30-025-39720, Unit D, Section 16, T25S-R35E. P&A (Date Plugged), 2010.
- Fill hole with sand.
