- 1. The Bureau of Land Management Carlsbad Field Office does not have Joseph Lindemood on record as an agent to submit documents for Snow Oil & Gas Inc. If an agent document has been filed, please submit a copy. If not, an agent document template is attached.
- 2. Sundry submitted by Chevron prior to operator change indicated casing problems for recompleting the well from the Wolfcamp to the Bone Spring formation.
- 3. Snow Oil & Gas Inc. took over operations effective March 22, 2007.
- 4. Operator submitted a sundry on July 24, 2007 with plans to recomplete from the Wolfcamp to the Bone Spring formation. Operator was instructed in the Conditions of Approval that the work must be completed within 90 days. Operator did not comply with the Condition.
- 5. Operator submitted a sundry on February 14, 2008 with plans to recomplete from the Wolfcamp to the Bone Spring formation. Operator was instructed on that sundry to return the well to production within 120 days or submit plans to plug and abandon. Operator did not comply with the Condition.
- 6. Pursuant to 43 CFR 3162.1(a), operator shall submit a Plug and Abandonment Procedure for this well by August 31, 2010. When the Plug and Abandonment sundry is approved, the operator will have 90 days to complete the plugging.
