Guidelines for Off-Lease Measurement, Storage and Surface Commingling Approvals

The following information must be included with any application to combine, store, or measure production off-lease:

1. A formal request (Sundry Notice Form 3160-5 or letter) for approval to combine, store, or measure production off-lease with an appropriate explanation and diagram(s) describing the proposed operation in detail.

Please see attached sundry notice.

2. A map showing the lease numbers and location of all leases and wells that will contribute production to the proposed commingling, off-lease measurement, and/or storage facility. All lease numbers, unitized or communitized areas, producing zones or pools must be clearly illustrated or detailed by suitable means. Any wells or leases proposed to be added to an approved commingling and off-lease storage and or measurement facility must be approved by the Authorized Officer prior to their being included in the facility.

Please see attached map.

3. An updated facility diagram which clearly identifies and places all equipment that will be utilized. This diagram should identify all sales points and give location of gas sales (transfer point) meter if it is not at this facility.

Please see attached facility diagram.

4. Estimated monthly production from each contributing well, including type of product, gravity, and/or BTU content.

Please see attachment for answers to this question.

5. Details of the proposed method for measuring and allocating production for each lease involved. Include calculated "beneficial use" volumes both on and off-lease.

Each well will be tested monthly using a PD Meter to measure the oil and water. The gas will be measured using the GOR.

6. A statement that all interest owners have been notified of the proposal.

All working, royalty, and overriding royalty interest owners have been notified. Please see attached list and certified receipts.

7. Evidence that Federal or Indian royalties will not be reduced through approval of the application, and the proposed commingling of production is in the interest of conservation and will not result in improper measurement of production.

There are no Indian royalties. This question does not apply.

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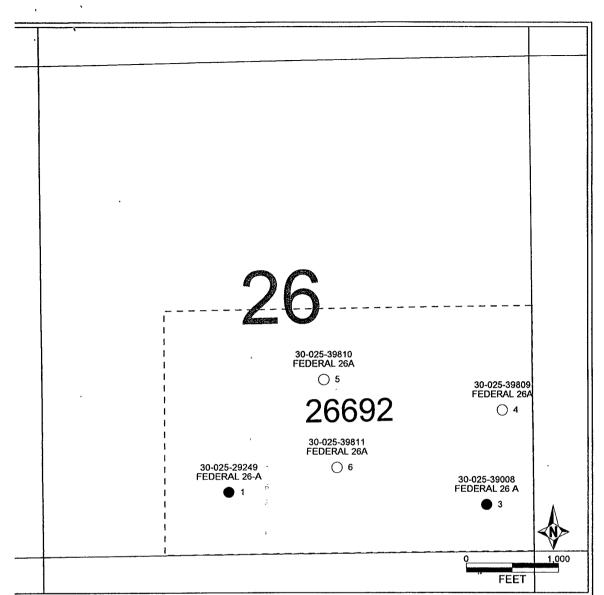

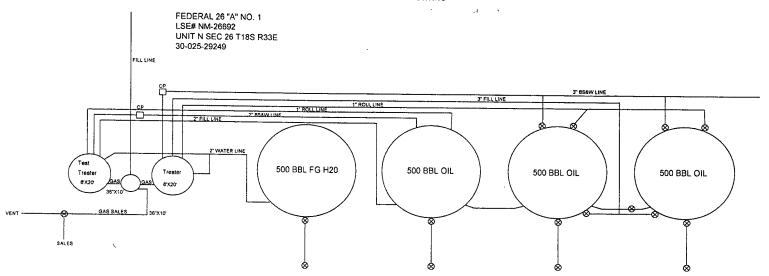

Condition of Approval Commingle on and off lease

- 1. This approval is subject to like approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.
- 2. This agency shall be notified of any spill or discharge as required by NTL-3A.
- 3. This agency reserves the right to modify or rescind approval whenever it determines continued use of the approved method may adversely affect the surface or subsurface environments.
- 4. This approval does not constitute right-of-way approval for any off-lease activities. Within 30 days, an application for right-of-way approval must be submitted to the Realty Section if not already done.
- 5. Approval for combining production from various sources is a privilege which is granted to lessees for the purpose of aiding conservation and extending the economic life of leases. Applicants should be cognizant that failure to operate in accordance with the provisions outlined in the Authorized Officer's conditions of approval and/or subsequent stipulations or modifications will subject such approval to revocation.

- 6. All above ground structures on the lease shall be painted Shale Green (5Y 4/2), or as per approved APD stipulations. This is to be done within 90 days, if you have not already done so.
- 7. Gas measurement for allocation must be measured as per Onshore Order #5 for sales meters.
- 8. All gas and oil subject to royalty shall be measured as per federal regulations and shall be reported to MMS as required. All gas which is vented, flared or used on lease shall be reported as per NTL-4A to MMS. All gas which is vented or flared shall be subject to royalty, unless prior approval was given by the authorized officer.
- 9. This agency shall be notified of any change in sales method or location of sales point.
- 10. Additional wells and/or leases require additional commingling approvals.
- 11. Down hole commingling required prior approval. Submit sundry and completion reports within 30 days of well being completed.
