13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operation: Clearly state all pertinent details, including estimated starting date of any proposed work and approximate duration thereof. 1. Remove well head, anchors, flowline, and all other debris from location and install dry hole marker
2. Remove caliche and contaminated soil from location and access road
3. Put in 2'-3' caliche for barrier where needed
4. Put in 1'-2' clean topsoil as needed
5. Level and contour to surrounding area
6. Build an earthen berm at access to prevent vehicular traffic
7. Rip and seed all disturbed areas with BLM # 2 seed mix
