Gentlemen:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is in receipt of your Final Abandoned Notice dated June 9, 2009 for the Federal Lease NMLC068474, Drickey QN Sand #21, API No.: 30-005-00965, 1980 FSL & 1980 FEL, NW¼SE¼ Section 3, T. 14 S. R. 31 E. Chaves County, New Mexico.

In response to your subsequent Sundry Notice dated November 2, 2010 on November 10, 2010, Randy Legler, Natural Resource Specialist for the BLM inspected the well site and has placed the site in a two year monitoring status pending satisfactory re-vegetation. The BLM will reinspect this location in approximately two years. When the site is determined to be in a safe, stable, and satisfactorily revegetated state the BLM will process and approve your request for Final Abandonment pursuant to Onshore Order #1 XII. B. which states "Final abandonment will not be approved until the surface reclamation work required ... has been completed to the satisfaction of the BLM ...".
