Plugging Procedure – Form C103 Attachment  
Rainbow “16” State Well # 1, API 30-025-39719  
January 5, 2011

The following plugging procedure is proposed to replace the one submitted in a previous C-103 dated July 12, 2010 due to a change in well conditions. This procedure has been reviewed in email form and tentatively approved by Mr. Larry Hill, subject to final approval.

The current depth of this well is only two (2) feet from ground surface, having filled back in with cavings and blow sand since being originally drilled to a depth of 25 feet in sand and caliche. Hole diameter is 12".

1. Dig well out to a depth of at least five feet below ground level.
2. Mix and displace quik-crete to within 3' of the surface.
3. Weld 10" diameter steel plate onto a two-foot length of steel tubing. Bolt an aluminum sign 10" in diameter onto the steel plate with the following information looking up:  
Robert E. Landreth- Rainbow 16 State Well No. 1, API No. 30-025-37919, Unit J,  
Section 16, T25S-R35E. P&A (Date Plugged), 2011
4. (This will be prepared and on location at the time the plugging procedure is initiated).
5. Stick the tubing into the wet concrete with name plate facing up. Fill hole to surface with sand.
6. Notify NMOCD office in Hobbs 24 hours prior to initiating this operation. Obtain GPS coordinates of the well (lat/lon) and submit on Subsequent Report.
7. Anticipated commencement date: within fourteen (14) days of approval, weather permitting. Work to be done by Merryman Construction, Jal, NM
