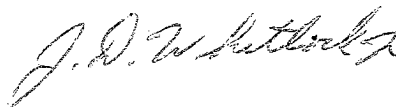

Please note on the resubmitted APDs that they were previously approved and we will review the expired files for information which will help expedite the processing.
