Reference is made to the following:

(a) your application (**administrative application reference No. pTGW11-05453515**) submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (the Division) in Santa Fe, New Mexico on February 23, 2011, and

(b) the Division's records pertinent to this request.

Celero Energy II, LP (Celero) has requested to drill the above-referenced well as a directional well to the Devonian formation. The well will be drilled from the surface location described in the caption of this letter to an unorthodox bottom hole location, 1372 feet from the South line and 1273 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 2. The NW/4 SW/4 of Section 2 will be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 40-acre, more or less, oil spacing unit in the Denton-Devonian Pool (16910).

Spacing in this pool is governed by statewide Rule 15.9, which provides for 40-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary. The proposed bottom hole location for this well is less than 330 feet from the unit boundaries.
