Yates Petroleum Corporation set conductor pipe on this well on February 28, 2011 to save Federal Lease NM-105888. On February 23, 2011 BLM approved a 30-day period to March 30, 2011 to move rig onto location to conduct diligent drilling operation. We are currently drilling the Vespa BME Federal #1H well with the Patriot Rig 511 rig, which we intend to move onto this well. Drilling on the Vespa well will not be completed until approximately April 1st or 2nd therefore Yates request a seven day extension till April 6th to move the rig onto this well and start the diligent drilling operations.
