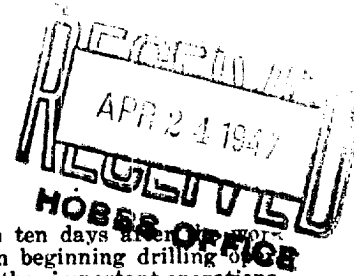

1 Joint (27'-0") 13" O.D. 61# pipe was cemented to surface on March 30, 1947, shut off test OK, plug drilled April 5, 1947.

10" O.D. 40# pipe was set at 460 feet with 25 Sx cement on April 11, 1947, shut off test OK, plug was drilled April 15, 1947, noted that 10" settled evidencing bad cement job. Well was conditioned and 10" pipem cemented with 100Sx (Halliburton) on April 16, 1947. Cement allowed to set 48 hours, shut off test OK. Plug was drilled April 18, 1947. Drilling ahead.
