To guard against mistakes or delays, the sender of a message should order it repeated, that is, telegraphed back to the originating office for confirmation. For this one-half the repeated message rate is charged in addition. Before attempting to send a message, the sender should be advised of the message rate and rate of transmission. If a receipt is agreed between

The carrier shall be liable for the delivery of any message received by the addressee at the unreported address or for non-delivery of any message received by the addressee at the reported address if the delay resulting from unstable intermediate mail sorting stations has caused the message to be delivered after expiration of its time.

any event the Commission shall have the right to require the sender of a message to pay the sum of five thousand dollars, or for the non-delivery of any message, whether caused by the sender or by the carrier, the sum of five thousand dollars, in each case, for every message in excess of the sum of five thousand dollars, at which amount the sender of each message represents that he is insured, unless a greater value is stated in writing at the time the message is tendered for transmission, and unless the repeated-message rate is paid or, in either case, the sender has taken such steps as to be required by the Commission to insure that the value of the message or the value of the property which such valuation shall exceed five thousand dollars.

2. The Company is hereby made the agent of the sender, without liability, to forward this message over the lines of any other company when necessary to reach its destination.

except as otherwise indicated in connection with the listing of individual places in the filed tariffs of the Company, the amount paid for the transmission of a domestic telegram is as shown in the following table. The Company is not operated through the use of telegraph offices where, as shown by the filed tariffs of the Company, the distance between the place of origin of the telegram and the place of destination is more than one mile of the telegraph line. In towns of less than 5,000 inhabitants where no office of the Company is maintained, telegrams may be sent by telephone to the nearest telegraph office, and will be delivered by the carrier, with the understanding that the sender will be responsible to pay such additional charges, if any, collected from the addressee. There will be no additional charges for the collection of any address or for any delay made by telephone which

responsibility attaching to this Chapter concerning messages of which the same are accepted at one of its transmitting offices; and if a message is sent to such office by one of its members, he shall be held responsible on the behalf of the service.

Company will not be liable for damages or costs of litigation or the cost of an intrastate meeting in Texas where the claim is not presented to a written hearing before the Company and its directors and in the case of an intrastate meeting in Texas the Company will not be liable for damages or costs where the claim is not presented in writing to the Company within ninety days after the cause of action, if any, shall have occurred; provided, however, that such limitation shall not apply to damages or costs of litigation which are awarded in Section 415 of the Communications Act of 1934.

CLASSES OF SERVICE

DOMESTIC SERVICES

FULL RATE TELEGRAMS

A full-rate expedited service.

DAY LETTERS

A deferred service at lower than the full rate

DETAILS

Measurements in sections during the same day

INLET LETTERS

delivered up to 3 A.M. for delivery not earlier than the following morning at rates substantially lower than the full rate telegram or day letter rates

CABLE SERVICES

FULL RATE CABLES

The standard fast service at full rates. May be written in any language that can be expressed in Roman letters or in cipher

CODE (CDE)

A fast message service consisting of words formed without condition or restriction, counted at 5 characters per word. Minimum charge of 5 words applies.

DEFERREDS (LC)

Plain language messages, subject to being detoured in favor of full rate and COMSEC messages.

NIGHT LETTERS (NLT)

Overnight plain-language messages. Minimum charge of 25 words applies.
