DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Widner #1 was drilled to a total depth of 7348' in granite. 13 3/8" OD 48# H-40 SS Csg was set at 372' and left in the hole, cement circulated. 8 5/8" OD 24# & 32# J-55 SS Csg. was set at 2678' and left in the hole, cement circulated. The hole was loaded with approximately 470 barrels of 10.2# mud laden fluid. Three cement plugs were spotted: 75 sacks (244') 7104-7348'; 75 sacks (244') 2506'-2750'; 10 sacks (30') in top of 8 5/8" csg. A 4" pipe marker has been installed to mark the abandoned location. Location has been leveled and cleared of junk. Plugging was witnessed by S. E. Woodruff, Assistant Production Foreman, Cities Service Oil Company, Box 97, Hobbs, New Mexico and L. L. Johnson, Box 1628, Hobbs, New Mexico, tool pusher for Makin Drilling Company. Plugging was completed on April 22, 1954. Verbal approval received prior to plugging.
