There is enclosed herewith one copy of the Notice of Transfer of Skarda well No. 1, Melrose, New Mexico, by Ray Pool Drilling Company, to The National Cooperative Refinery Association, McPherson, Kansas, and the request of the Ray Pool Drilling Company, to be relieved of further responsibility on their bond posted for the drilling of said well. The transfer has been accepted by The National Cooperative Refinery Association, McPherson, Kansas, by acceptance in writing immediately under the transfer made by the Ray Pool Drilling Company. A complete description of the bond and the well is shown on the back of the transfer and acceptance.
