



BEFORE ME, the undersigned, a Notary Public in and for said County, State of New Mexico, on this day personally appeared John Garrett, Jr., to me well known, and that, after being by me duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is John Garrett, Jr., and I am the present owner of lands more particularly described as Section 34, T-5-N, R-34-E, Curry County, New Mexico. Texas Gulf Producing Company is now engaged in the drilling of a well in search of oil and gas at a location in Section 34, said well being designated as Texas Gulf's Garrett Well #1. In the event that efforts to complete this well as a well producing oil or gas are unsuccessful it is my request that the well be abandoned in the following manner - Texas Gulf shall leave the 13" casing previously installed and cemented in said well at a depth of approximately 560' and also leave the 9 5/8" casing previously set in said well to a depth of approximately 2600'. Texas Gulf is requested to set a bridge plug at approximately 2600' with a 50' cement plug to be set at the top of said bridge plug and to set such other plugs below 2600' as may be necessary to comply with regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. I do not desire that the well be plugged and abandoned in the usual manner, it being my desire to have the well left in such a condition that it may be useable by me as a water well. The purpose of this affidavit is to confirm that this method of abandonment is satisfactory to me as the land owner concerned.
