Cement plugs were placed in the well by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company from 10,700' - 10,850', and attempt made to place plug from 8864' to 9010'. Went back in to dress off top of plug with bit and found top of plug at 9037'. Drilled from 9037' to 9048'. Found good hard cement plug. Placed 30,000 lbs. of weight on plug which held o. k.
