

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cement plugs were put in the well by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company as follows: 3420' - 3550'; 4770' - 4900'; 6220' - 6350'; 7070' - 7200'; 8770' - 8915'. The plug from 3420' - 3550', plugs off the bottom of the 8-5/8" casing. We were only able to pull 1 - 30' joint of 8-5/8" casing. A 15 sack cement plug was placed in the top of the 13-3/8" casing with marker.
