DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was drilled to a total depth of 3516 feet in dolomite. Ran 125 Joints 8-5/8 O.D. 32# Casing, Cemented with 200 sacks 2% gel., 300 sacks 4% gel. Plug was down 2:00 A.M., March 24, 1954. The cement was allowed to set 36 hours. The Casing Shut off was tested with 1000# pressure, all valves closed during a 30 minute period and no drop in pressure was noted. Drilling was then resumed.
