DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was drilled to a total depth of 450 feet in Red Beds. Ran 11 Joints 13-3/8 O.D. Spiral weld casing set at 450 feet. Cemented with 450 sacks. Plug Down 11:00 P.M. 3-16-54. Cement Circulated and was allowed to set 36 hours, 1000# pressure applied with all valves closed. No drop in pressure during a 30 minute period was noted. Drilling was then resumed.
