Plug #1 - 9082' with 30 sax cement - displaced with 124 bbls. mud; top cement estimated 8996. Cement in place 2:30 PM 8/17

Plug #2 - 3595 with 65 sax cement - displaced with 47 1/2 bbls. mud; top cement estimated 3425. Cement in place 4:45 PM 8/17

Plug #3 - Plugged top of surface pipe with 10 sax cement. Cemented 10' piece of 4" pipe in top of surface casing with 4' above ground. Finished at 12 o'clock noon 8/18/52
