This well was drilled to 3471' in lime. Ran 88½ joints (3455.75') of 9 5/8" OD 32.3# and 36# casing and set at 3470.05'. Cemented with 1844 sacks of cement containing 4% gel and 102 sacks of strata crete. Followed w/400 sacks of neat cement. Cement circulated. Final Pressure 1150#. Plug was down at 11:20 PM 7-30-52. Cement will be allowed to set 48 hours before testing for shut-off.
