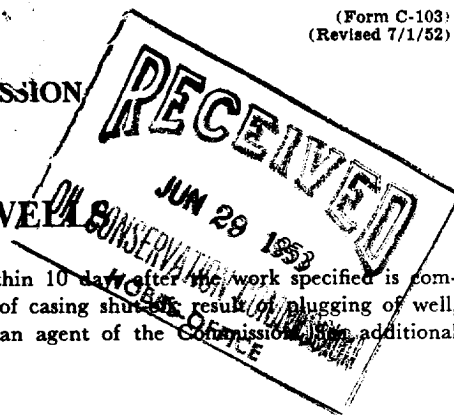

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

State "AD" #2 was drilled to a total depth of 10,491' in lime. 13 3/8" OD 48# H-40 SS Casing was set at 392' and left in the hole, cement circulated. 8 5/8" OD 24# & 32# Casing was set at 3540' and left in hole, cement circulated. The hole was loaded with approximately 650 bbls of 10.4 mud laden fluid. Four plugs, consisting of 50 sacks of cement each, were spotted at 10,331' to 10,491', 8640' to 8800', 8190' to 8350', 3575' to 3415' respectively, each plug being approximately 160' in length. An additional 10' plug was placed in the top of 8 5/8" casing. A 4" pipe marker has been installed to mark the abandoned location. The pits have been filled and leveled and location cleared of junk.

Wm. McDonald, Tool Pusher for Guy Mabee Drilling Company, Odessa, Texas, W. E. Dickey, Production Foreman, Cities Service Oil Company, Hobbs, New Mexico were in charge of the work.
