## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Rigged-up, pulled rods, pump and tubing; reran tubing open ended; loaded hole with 19 1/2 barrel of oil, pressured up to 2400# and formation started taking oil, pumped in 60 barrel at 3000# CP, 2400# TP. Dolofraced with 10,000 gallon and 5000# sand, CP 3500#, TP 4200#, no break, flush with 114 bbls of oil, total oil and dolofrac 801 barrel. SI 6 hours. Ran swab 3 times and well kicked off and flowed 412 barrel in 11 hours. The remainder of the load was recovered by swabbing and flowing. The well was then put on the pump and was pumped to clean-up. After the well was thoroughly cleaned up, it was tested and produced 132 barrel of oil and 72 barrel of water in 24 hours with a GOR of 1591.
