DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

State "AD" #3 was drilled to a total depth of 3444' in lime. Ran 3413.32' (80 1/3 Jts) of 8 5/8" OD 32# and 28# SS Csg set at 3442' and cemented with 2212 sacks regular cement of which 1812 sacks contained 4% jel and 75 sacks strota crete and 400 sacks was neat on bottom. Circulated out approximately 30 sacks. Plug down at 9:45 A.M. 6-27-53. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours, 1000# pressure was applied with all valves closed for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Test was satisfactory and drilling resumed.
