DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

State "AD" #4 was drilled to a total depth of 3440' in lime. Ran 3422.55' (87 1/2 jts) of 8 5/8" OD 32#, 28# and 24# J-55 and H-40 8R thd ss Csg., set at 3439' and cemented with 2150 sacks of cement of which 1750 sacks contained 4% gel and 400 sacks was neat on bottom. Circulated out 550 sacks. Plug down at 12:30 P.M. 4-5-54. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours, 1000# pressure was applied with all valves closed for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Test was satisfactory and drilling was resumed.
