Re: Intent to Re-enter State #1-A, Sec.11, T11S, R32E

Gentlemen:

Your intention to re-enter the Lawton, State #1 well has been received. It is noted that you have proposed a gas well and have dedicated 320 acres which you are in the process of communitizing. However, the location, 660/N and 660/E is non-standard for a gas well to this depth. Statewide gas spacing is no nearer than 1980' from end boundary and 660' from side boundary and your location is non-standard in relation to the side boundary.

Since this is a re-entry you most likely will be able to obtain approval of this unorthodox location by the administrative process as allowed by our Rule 104 (F), copy enclosed.

As soon as your bond is approved we will go ahead and approve this re-entry with a stipulation that it cannot be produced as a Mississippian gas well until the non-standard location has been approved.
