# APPLICATION OF RHOMBUS ENERGY COMPANY FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Rhombus Energy Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on April 26, 1996, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its C.W. Robinson 'A' Well No.2 located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 14, Township 11 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

### THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

(1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;

(2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified;

(3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met; and

(4) One objection has been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule. Such objection has been satisfied and withdrawn by same party.

### **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

The applicant herein, is hereby authorized to complete its C.W.Robinson 'A' Well No.2 located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 14, Township 11 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Devonian formation at approximately 10,616 feet to 10,660 feet through 2 7/8-inch plastic-lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 10,520 feet.
