DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3469' Total Depth. Line. Finished drilling 11" hole @ 12:30 AM on 4/6/53. Ran a total of 87 joints of 8-5/8" OD casing set @ 3469' and cemented with 1500 sacks of cement. Plug pumped to 3422' at 2:30 PM, 4/6/53. Max. Pressure - 1200#. Ran temperature survey - top of cement outside of 8-5/8" OD casing at 1070' - 47.0% fill. After WOG for 24 hours tested 8-5/8" OD casing with 1000# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 3422' to 3469'. Tested 8-5/8" OD casing with 1000# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Started drilling 7-7/8" hole at 3:30 AM on 4/8/53
