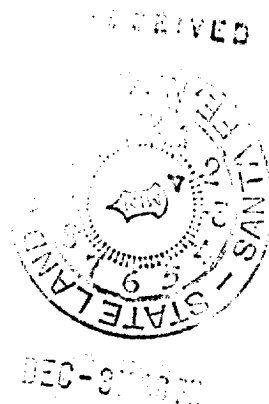

Dear Sir:

Shortly after the first of this year, we completed a well which was a dry hole in section 14-11S-32E, Lea County, New Mexico, which was plugged. We were required to make a dry hole plugging bond to meet with the requirements of your State. We are now trying to get this bond released in order that we will not have to pay the \$50.00 bond premium again this year.

The insurance carrier requires a release from the Oil Conservation before it will cancel out the bond. We have been endeavoring for a month now to get this. We called Mr. J. W. Brown at Midland, Texas, as soon as we learned that it was necessary that we get a release from you and he said that he would get the release for us. We heard nothing further from him, so we next wrote to the C and G Oil Company and Mr. Ira Dillard advised us that at the time the well was plugged Mr. Brown took all responsibility of filing plugging reports. We then sent a telegram to Mr. Brown advising him of what Mr. Dillard had written to us and he wired back that the reports had been filed and that he would call you and advise us. This was a week ago and we have heard nothing further from him.

Naturally, we are desirous of getting this bond cancelled and we would appreciate it very much if you would advise us just what the status of this matter is. Mr. Brown told us over the telephone that he would have to get this from Carlsbad, however, not being familiar with the laws of the State of New Mexico, we are at a loss to know how to proceed in this matter.
