3460' - Total Depth - Lime. Finished drilling 11" hole @ 5 AM, 1/27/53 - Ran a total of 83 Jts of 8-5/8" OD Casing set @ 3460' w/725 Sx Reg. mixed 2% Jel, 725 Sx Pennam and 50 Sx Incer Cement - Total 1500 Sx. Pumped plug to 3378' @ 3:35 PM, 1/27/53 - Max pressure, 800'. Ran Temperature Survey - top of cement outside 8-5/8" casing @ 1015', or 47.4% fill. After WOC for 24 hours, tested casing for 1/2 hour with 1200# - no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 3378' to 3460' and tested casing for 1/2 hour with 1200# - no pressure drop. Started drilling formation and 7-7/8" hole @ 4:30 AM, 1/29/53 -
