346' 13-3/8" casing set at 358' with 350 sacks cement. Cement circulated.
 3612' 8-5/8" casing set at 3625' with 2300 sacks cement. Cement circulated.

This well was drilled to a total depth of 11,942' without encountering oil or gas in commercial quantities. This well has been abandoned, salvaged and plugged in the following manner:

Using heavy mud between plugs, spotted the following cement plugs:
 30 sacks 11,942-11,842; 30 sacks 11,270-11,170; 30 sacks 8540-8440; 30 sacks 7330-7230; 30 sacks 6530-6430; 30 sacks 5035-4935; 30 sacks 3675-3575; 10 sacks in top of 8-5/8" casing. (All 13-3/8" and 8-5/8" casing left in hole.) Completed April 10, 1952.
