DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

11,260' TD 11,190' FWD Line - Ran Baker Model K C.I. Retainer and out @ 11,190' and squeezed open hole from 11,204' to 11,260' with 100 sacks cement. Top of cement inside 5-1/2" casing @ 11,190'. Perforated 5-1/2" OD casing (11,143' to 11,171' and 11,176' to 11,189') with 4 bullet shots per foot. Ran 2" tubing and packer and acidized 5-1/2" OD casing perforations with 1000 gallons Western 19% HCl acid.

Production test of July 6, 1935: Well flowed 245 bbls oil and 15 bbls acid water in 24 hrs on 10/64" choke. TP - 900'.
