DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

11,336' Total Depth. Lins. Spotted 35 sack regular cement plug on bottom from 11,221' to 11,336', filled hole with heavy mud and spotted 65 sack regular cement plug from 8389' to 8800'; filled hole with heavy mud from 8389' to 3610' and spotted 35 sack regular cement plug from 3498' to 3610'; filled hole with heavy mud and spotted 10 sack regular cement plug in top of 8-5/8" casing. Cement had circulated on 8-5/8" casing when ran and therefore did not salvage any portion of casing from hole. A piece of 4" line pipe extending 5' above ground level placed in top of 8-5/8" casing to serve as marker. - Well plugged and abandoned 3/14/53.
