Lea County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well was tested in the Wolfcamp formation and found to be non-commercial. It is desired to extend this well to the Devonian pay around 11,100'. Due to the presence of a fault of Pennsylvanian age near this well, and the fact that it is being drilled on an expired lease, makes it necessary that this well be extended to the Devonian pay by controlled, directional drilling so the pay will be intercepted at a point 550' from each the south and west lines of the unit in a manner by which at no point will this hole be nearer than 330' to any unit line.

This plan was approved by telephone by Mr. R. R. Spurrier, State Geologist, 2-11-53. Confirmed by wire 2-11-53.
