### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3616' Total Depth, Lime. Ran Schlumberger and Land Wells Gamma Ray Surveys. Plugged bottom of the hole from 3616' to 3563' with 10 sx cement and bottom of 7" casing from 3099' to 3025' with 15 sx cement. Job complete at 3:00PM, 1-25-48. Shot 7" OD Casing 7 times until 2:00AM, 1-26-48 with 2½ qts. Nitroglycerin each shot at 1552', 1491', 1397', 1367', 1335', 1304' and 1273'. Spotted 120 bbls. oil and worked pipe until 10:30PM, 1-27-48, when pipe came loose. Recovered 38 jts. of 7" OD, 22# Casing for 1178'. Bridged 10-3/4" casing and put in top plug of 15 sx cement with 4" pipe 5' high in center of plug. Job complete at 10:30AM, 1-28-48.
