This well was drilled to a total depth of 11,518 feet without encountering oil or gas in commercial quantities; therefore, we desire to abandon, salvage and plug well in the following manner; Spot the following cement plugs:

30 sacks from 11,477' to 11,377'
30 sacks from 10,808' to 10,708'
30 sacks from 10,232' to 10,132'
30 sacks from 8,497' to 8,397'
30 sacks from 7,307' to 7,207'
30 sacks from 6,520' to 6,420'
30 sacks from 5,054' to 4,954'
30 sacks from 3,710' to 3,610'

10 sacks in top of casing and place usual maker.
