with 125 sacks cement. Plug pumped to 155' @ 4:30 PM, 8-18-54.
Max. pump pressure - 100#. Cement circulated estimated 15 sacks.
After W.O.C. for 24 hours - tested 13-3/8" OD casing with 200#
for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 155' to 165'
and tested 13-3/8" OD casing with 200# for 1/2 hour - no pressure
drop.
