DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was dry at total depth of 3102'. The Queen Sand was from 3069-3081. We placed 25 sacks of cement at 3050 on top of the Queen Sand; placed 25 sacks of cement at 2200 (base of Salt); placed 25 sacks of cement at 1600' (top of Salt); and 15 sacks of cement at surface. We then welded steel identification plate on top--4" above ground level ---all in accordance with your regulations.

The pits have been filled at this well and the location has been cleared and restored as nearly as possible to its former condition. Mr. Glenn has been paid for all location damages.
