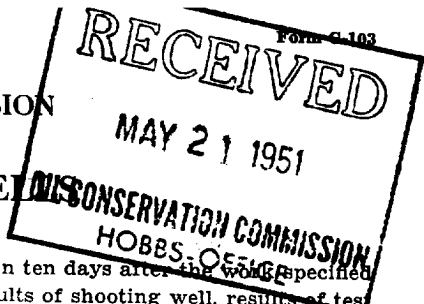

3662' - Total Depth - Line. Ran Temperature Survey - Top of cement on outside of 8-5/8" casing at 1538', ratio of actual to calculated fill 42.7%. Checked top of cement at 3580'. Tested casing & connections W/1200# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 3580' to 3662' & tested casing & connections with 1200# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Started drilling formation and 7-7/8" hole at 11:00 A.M., 5-17-51.
