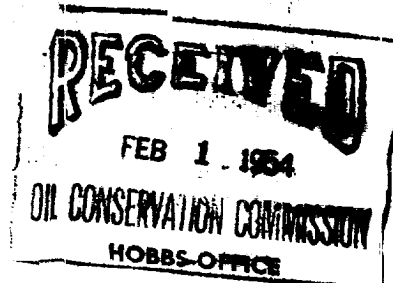

blanket bond; Standard Accident Insurance Co.; 2-20-53

The Commission has received affidavit attesting to the fact that only one well was drilled under coverage of the captioned bond, that being your Will C. Speed No. 1 Well, SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 14, Township 12 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and that said well has been properly plugged in conformance with Commission requirements.

A check of the well file shows that on November 3, 1953, Form C-102 was approved denoting the operator's intention to plug the well, but the final form (C-103) has apparently never been submitted to show that the plugging was actually accomplished. These should have been submitted in the usual manner to the Commission's office at Hobbs. We are sending blank forms to Brown & Wheeler, and also are sending a copy of this letter to our Hobbs office. If the forms are approved without delay, you should be able to secure release of the bond before your anniversary date of February 16, 1953, as shown on the face of the bond.
