Set 13-3/8"OD 36# Armo Spiral Welded Casing at 172'. Cemented with 175 sacks Longhorn cement (Portland) w/ 6% Gel. Circulated cement to surface.

Used a Texas Pattern Guide Shoe. Used single plug stopping same at 145' by Halliburton wire line measurements.

W.O.C. - 24 hrs. Tested casing with water to 500 psi for 30 minutes- held O.K.
